### Mickey's ABC's and Mickey's 123's

Mickey's ABC's and Mickey's 123's owners no longer have to select a graphic mode each time you load your programs -- it's automatically selected for you.

Please disregard all references to selecting a graphics mode in the Instruction Guide and Quick Start card.

If you DO want to force your program to run in a certain graphics mode, you must load the program by typing ONE of the following commands and pressing Enter:

MICKEY /EGA (to force EGA graphics mode)

MICKEY /CGA (to force CGA graphics mode)

MICKEY /TANDY (to force Tandy graphics mode)

The Sound Source ON and OFF commands covered in the Troubleshooting Guide section still work. To use the ON or OFF command, just type it after MICKEY and before the graphics mode (if you're forcing a graphics mode). For example, to force the program to load with the Sound Source on and in EGA mode, you'd type MICKEY ON /EGA.
